The most important wedding photos are the ones that help the couple remember the important moments and people from their wedding day. Instead of trying to nail everything on a huge shot list, focus on what's important when it comes to your wedding and when it comes to your particular needs as a couple.

Partnering in marriage is a great milestone in a person's life. These are special moments and you want to preserve these memories in your life. Wedding photographers are the ones who can help make your memories last forever.

Our relationship affects your photos. Not only will you remember the person who made your photos as you look at them, but you're letting us into a really intimate time of your lives, and that's some vulnerable space! If we truly click, like you would honestly go out for a beverage with me, your photos are going to show that. I know exactly what you are looking for from your wedding day. An incredible celebration, that is memorable and of course, stress-free with amazing wedding photos that will last the test of time and allow you to relive said incredible memories.

Is it possible to have a fusion of amazing photography and a relaxed, fun day without feeling like you are in a photo shoot as a bride or groom? You bet it is.

BONUS TIP:

Avoid glossy lipstick and consider foundation or powder that will reduce the chance of having a shiny face. Please note mineral makeup causes unflattering effects with flash due to elements that reflect light in them. Glittery and shimmering powder is also a bad choice for the entire bridal party.

I am so happy to help you create a photo/video timeline for your wedding day. 2 weeks before your wedding I will reach out to request a general timeline for the day.(general timeline page is in the questionnaire in this guide) From that timeline I will create a photo/video timeline so you can see when and where all of the photos will be taken throughout the day and can share that information with the loved ones and other vendors.

It's a good idea to allow a little extra time between transitions or location changes from the ceremony to the reception. This leaves time for equipment movement and set up as well as space if things are running a little behind. This is what i mean by "Breathable". 2 weeks before your wedding I will request a family formal list (in this guide). This is a list of about 10 combinations of immediate family that you would like "formal" photos with right after the ceremony, including their names and relations. For family formal photos we estimate 2-3 minutes for each combination. So 10 combinations mean 20-30 minutes of formal photo time.

Let all close family members know that you want them to stay at the ceremony site for family portraits. Sometimes family members (yes, even close ones like grandparents) forget or don't realize they need to stay for the family portraits. It takes time to gather lost family members and is much easier when they all know prior to the wedding day.

GATHER ITEMS FOR DETAIL SHOTS

The rings, bouquets, wedding invitations, jewelry, boutonnieres, shoes, perfume and cufflinks are all gorgeous details that shouldn't be forgotten! It's helpful for your wedding photographer to rely on a wedding party member or other helper to organize these items, so make sure to keep them close!

Don't limit yourself to this list, though! If you have any items that are meaningful to your relationship (such as love letters, keepsakes/tokens, souvenirs, borrowed items, etc..) those make wonderful additions to your detail photos. You can also think outside the box!

Don't forget to have your dress hanging on a beautiful hanger for those epic dress hanging photos at the beginning of the day.







THE FIRST LOOK

I absolutely love this modern twist on the traditional wedding that gives you and your fiancé the opportunity to see each other for the first time in a more intimate setting. You could choose a more scenic location, or just have a first talk or handhold around the corner/behind a door so you don't see each other.





A first look doesn't have to happen right before you walk down the aisle, many couples choose to do a first look a few hours before the ceremony. A first look gives you more time to spend with your significant other during the calmer part of the wedding day before you are sharing your time with your loved ones and guests.

Seeing each other earlier in the day opens up the possibility of getting some group/family/wedding party photos out the way prior to the ceremony, which means that you don't have to spend as much time away from your guests and your party later on in the day. Reception guests love not having to wait as long for dinner to be served too!



extra hours of photo or video coverage

Most weddings can be captured within 6-9 hours. However, Some weddings require a little extra time needed for photo/video coverage (Weddings with Multiple locations, early morning start times, or unexpected delays during the reception) In this event Ala Carte hours are an extra \$350/per hour for just photography and \$500/hour for Photo and video coverage.

Film Photography

While digital photography remains a for most wedding staple photographers, requests for film have been on the rise. I first learned photography by taking film photos and would love to capture some highlights of your day on film in addition to capturing every moment in digital form. The film photography add on includes 20 FIIm prints from your wedding day (also delivered digitally) and is an addition cost of \$250.

Drone video services

We are now offering Drone video coverage as an Ala Carte add on. From overhead shots of the ceremony & reception venues, to pulled back views of golden hour couple portraits, this method definitely can bring more gravitas to your wedding highlight video. It gives such a grand and different perspective of an event or moment. Adding Drone coverage does mean that there is set apart specific timing for the videographer to capture these views. When choosing this add on you will need to set apart 30 min from your wedding day for the couple portion and an additional time for the videographer to capture the reception and ceremony locations. This add on is \$250

ENGAGEMENT Session advice

WEAR SOMETHING YOU CANNOT WAIT TO WEAR!

This is by far one of the most important tips we can give you. Choosing outfits that make you feel like a million bucks is key. If you purchase something new, take it out for a test run. You also want to think about how it'll photograph during your session. Move around in the outfit, see if it puckers in any ways you don't like. See is it lays nicely for sitting photos as well as standing photos.

Think about where these photos will be seen. If you are planning on using these photos for your wedding save the dates, invites, or at your ceremony and reception it would be great to incorporate your wedding colors into your outfits for cohesiveness.

Choose outfits that feel like an elevated version of your typical style. Add a little pop of a color, pattern, or texture that makes the outfit special.

Make sure to coordinate your outfits together, but don't necessarily match exactly. When choosing outfits find one item of clothing or an accessory that completely fits the vibe you are going for, then draw , colors from it to find the rest of the outfit.


Consider your location and the weather when choosing your outfits. The more comfortable you are in these elements the more natural your photos will turn out.





We encourage couples to go to places they love. This could be the place where you first met, a cafe or brewery, or perhaps in your own home. Your story is unique, and your photos should reflect that. This is the perfect opportunity to visit a place that you have always wanted to go on a date at as well I have a location guide that I will send you to help you feel inspired by where past clients have taken their photos.







SCHEDULE THE SESSION AROUND THE SUN

You may be familiar with the term "golden hour" aka the beautiful time of day just before the sun sets. This is when you want to shoot if you're looking for that warm light in your photos. Once your date is chosen for your engagement photos I will Plan ahead to find out when sunset is ensuring that we have plenty of time to shoot before the light is gone. The early afternoon may sound like a good time for photos schedule-wise, but keep in mind that the light is much harsher at this time because the sun is directly overhead which casts dark shadows on faces. Early morning light can also be magical, so if you're a morning person, consider scheduling your shoot for an hour after sunrise. NOT ONLY IS SHE FREAKING TALENTED. BUT SHE IS SO DOWN TO EARTH. SWEET. AND KIND.

Do you bring a second photographer?

YES! All of my packages (expect elopements or courthouse weddings) come with a second photographer! The second photographer covers the groom getting ready and provides alternate angles with focus on candid moments throughout the day. The second photographer also is a backup for the main photographer in case of emergency.

How soon will we receive our photos?

Your photos will be complete within 90 days from your wedding date. You will however receive a large next day preview to hold you over until your full gallery is complete!





Are you willing to travel?

Definitely! Travel fees are applied if I'm traveling over 1 1/2 hours to a location. Destinations that exceed two hours driving time each way may require overnight accommodations. Please inquire with your specific location for details of pricing.

Do you offer payment plans and how to you take payment?

YES! I break all of my packages into 4 equal payments spread equally until the week before your wedding. The first payment is your retainer and is due in order to place your wedding date in my calendar. Your payment plan with due dates will be laid out in your contract.

I take payments through invoices sent out though my website. Your are able to pay these invoices with either paypal or credit card.






Should I add Videography?

I often get this question, but it really does depend on your personal preferences and budget. The things that video offers in addition to photography is lifelong audio of loved ones and moments from your wedding day that you may not remember if not for having them on video. It is also a totally different art form that adds a lot of emotion to the preservation of your wedding memories.

Do you have backup equipment?

Yes! We bring backup cameras, batteries, sd cards etc to every wedding. Your can also feel secure in knowing that I buy new SD cards for every wedding I photograph, so there is never a formatting issue and I will have your RAW photos forever.





What is your cancellation and reschedule policy?

If the Client reschedules the wedding and the Photographer has the new date available, all money paid up until that point shall be transferred to the new date and the parties will adjust the contract accordingly to indicate the new Wedding Date. If Photographer is unavailable on the new date, it will be treated as a cancellation, discussed next. If the Client cancels the wedding or Photographer's services 90 days or more before the wedding, then any amounts paid will be refunded to Client, except for the deposit, which is nonrefundable. If the Client cancels the wedding or Photographer's services 89 days or less prior to the date of the wedding, the deposit plus any other amounts paid are nonrefundable, as Photographer is unlikely to book a wedding so close to the date.

How Do I Book A Date?

Once we have our phone consultation, I receive your signed contract, and receive your deposit/retainer/1st payment you will officially be in my calendar for your selected wedding date.
